


A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Keys No. 303 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuance of such Act:
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act, 1983.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than forty kilometres per hour on a public highway within the hamlet of Crystal Lake.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected on all streets entering the hamlet and shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone area.
4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
