

BYLAW NO. 93-2

A BYLAW to authorize the Rural Municipality of Keys No. 303 to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making ridges and erecting snow fences, under the provisions of Section 206 (2) (1) of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Keys No. 303 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows;

1. That the municipality may enter with their equipment upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges and erecting snow fences.
2. That the Council of the municipality may authorize any person or persons, with their private equipment, or Snow Plow Clubs with their equipment, to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting snow fences.
