

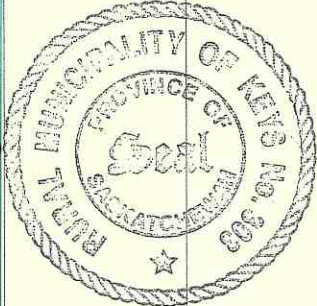
BYLAW NO. 2017-02

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS OF SIXTY KM PER HOUR ON MUNICIPAL ROADS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Keys No 303, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Speed Limit 60 Bylaw".
2. Speed:
 - i) No person shall operate a vehicle which is greater than seven (7) tonne at a speed greater than Sixty (60) km per hour in the speed zones in areas as set out in Appendix 1.
3. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed by *The Summary Offences Procedure Act* and any other applicable legislation.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of clause 2 of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
5. Any person who is in contravention of this bylaw may make a voluntary payment as per Section 10(1) of *The Summary Offences Procedure Act* equivalent to the Provincial rates.

SPEEDING ZONES [Section 2]

1. ALL MUNICIPAL ROADS EXCEPTING ROADS:

- a. Roads within the Hamlet of Crystal Lake**
