WATERWORKS POLICY

Policy

The Organized Hamlet of Crystal Lake operates a Seasonal Waterline for use around Crystal Lake. This waterline operates from mid-May until mid-October, weather dependent. It is not metered.

Septic Systems are individual septic tanks and are cleaned out as required at the owner's expense. There is a contract in place to use the Village of Stenen's Lagoon.

Due to Self-Declared GUDI, this system is currently a hygienic only system until a new water source can be located. Water Security Agency has given us until the end of 2025 to fix the problem.

- The charges to be paid by water consumers shall be \$150.00 per annum.

FUTURE CAPITAL PLANS

There are two plans in the works to fix the GUDI issues:

- Regional Waterline
 - SaskWater is investigating a new Regional Waterline from the Town of Preeceville to the Village of Pelly. The cost estimates should be given to us by the end of 2022.
- New Wells
 - This involves hiring an engineer to locate a new source of water which removes the possibility of being GUDI. There are a few locations which are being targeted.
