Development Permits

There are two types of permits required in the entire Rural Municipality of Keys (Both rural and hamlet). Available on the website and at the office.

Developmental Permit



This permit determines where the buildings are on your individual property. This ensures site lines and other standards are met. This is required for <u>all</u> development on the property including sheds.

- Building Permit
 - This permit is required for <u>all</u>
 <u>buildings</u> attached to sleeping
 quarters, detached garage and
 decks. In Crystal Lake, this
 includes any building over 100
 square feet.
- According to the Fees Bylaw, if either of these permits are not obtained, those costs are doubled.
- Please ensure all setbacks are adhered to. Call the office or check the Zoning Bylaws on the website for more details.

Any work being completed near water must have an Aquatic Habitat Protection Permit. Please visit https://www.wsask.ca/water-programs/aquatic-habitat-protection/ or phone 1-866-727-5420 for more information.

Bridge to Culvert Projects

The Municipality has been approved for the 2023 ICIP Grant to replace two bridges to culverts.

Locations:

- NE 04-33-02-W2
- SE 35-33-03-W2

Planned to be completed in 2024. The ICIP Grant is a 50% cost sharing grant between the Municipality and the Province (33.33%) and Federal (16.67%) governments with an anticipated cost of \$500,000 per project.

Division 3 Washout

Due to the high water this spring the culverts at SE 16-31-03-W2 was washed out and as a result we had to close this road. Please take extreme care if going near this area.

We have joined with PDAP and will be getting this replaced and plan to be completed in 2024.

Beaver Control

The Beaver Bounty program is in effect again. The municipality will reimburse Licensed Trappers \$30.00 per beaver if caught within the RM of Keys. Forms can be found on the municipal website, please contact the councillor to verify the counts.



If you catch beavers outside the Municipality, please do not expect to be paid and you could be placed on a banned list.

Crystal Lake

The Annual General Meeting will be held on August 11, 2024 @ 10:00 am at the Ukrainian Orthodox Church Camp. The Rec Committee will be sponsoring a pancake breakfast at the camp beginning at 8:00 am.

The Hamlet Board of Crystal Lake is planning on building a washroom facility on its public beach this fall. This washroom will have two bay washroom/change rooms with a newly constructed covered picnic shelter.

Crystal Lake is having issues with the email system so the information emails may not be getting to all cabin owners. Please use the Hamlets website for the main tool for communication www.hamletofcrystallake.ca

The Hamlet Board following the advice of the Crystal Lake Water Quality Committee is discouraging water-based activities that require a sustained "non-planed, bow-high" boat configuration (example: wake surfing). This causes large damaging waves as well as bottom scouring which stirs up and re-distributes sediments. If your boating activities are in deeper water, at high speed, on plane and not plowing the water then there is no concern.

Road Allowances are 66 feet wide

Over the last number of years, seeding and spraying crops on road allowances has been more prevalent. Farming up to the edge of developed roads undermines the structure and durability of the roads causing road and drainage issues.

The mower operators have been instructed not to cut around crops on the road allowances. If you wish to close and lease road allowances, please contact the office.

Weed Control

The Municipality has contracted Marksmen Vegetation Management to spray our noxious weeds. Over the last two years, we have targeted leafy spurge, and burdock. Now that we are working to control our weeds, Council requests that every ratepayer to try to clean up their noxious weeds. If you require extra help, we can contact our weed control contractor.

The Municipality started a mulching program a few years ago. With equipment being larger, there is a need for road allowances to be widened. We have spent \$30,000 to \$40,000 per year and have a set rotation. If you feel a road allowance needs to be widened, please contact the office and we will look at the individual site.
