WATERWORKS POLICY

Policy

The Organized Hamlet of Crystal Lake operates a Seasonal Waterline for use around Crystal Lake. This waterline operates from mid-May until mid-October, weather dependent. It is not metered.

Septic Systems are individual septic tanks and are cleaned out as required at the owner’s expense. There is a contract in place to use the Village of Stenen’s Lagoon.

Due to Self-Declared GUDI, this system is currently a hygienic only system until a new water source can be located. Water Security Agency has given an extension until June 2029 to fix the problem.

- The charges to be paid by water consumers shall be \$200.00 per annum.
